I can:

- Identify some of the countries where Spanish is spoken;
- Recognise some physical features of *Andalucía* from photographs;
- Use webcams to observe the weather;
- Recognise classical guitar music;
- Recognise some paintings by Picasso and Miró;
- Recognise some Spanish food;
- Talk about some celebrations that are special for me and other people;
- Listen to a Spanish singer on a CD;
- Sing some Spanish songs from memory;
- Recognise some Spanish names;
- Listen to a story in Spanish;
- Use the illustrations and my experience of similar stories to help me understand a story in Spanish;
- Sort words into dictionary order;
- Find English and Spanish headwords in a dictionary;
- Read Spanish story books by myself;
- Read some phrases in a story book;
- Listen to and join in with stories and songs;
- Identify rhyming words in a story or song;
- Count how many times I hear a particular word in a story or song;
- Count sets of objects and notice how the plural sounds;
- Spell some Spanish words;
- Memorise sequences of words;
- Build a simple sentence;
- Use simple punctuation;
- Count to 31;
- Use my knowledge of English to help me understand Spanish.
