In this Reading Diary you can keep a record of the stories that have been read to you, by writing down the title and the name of the author.

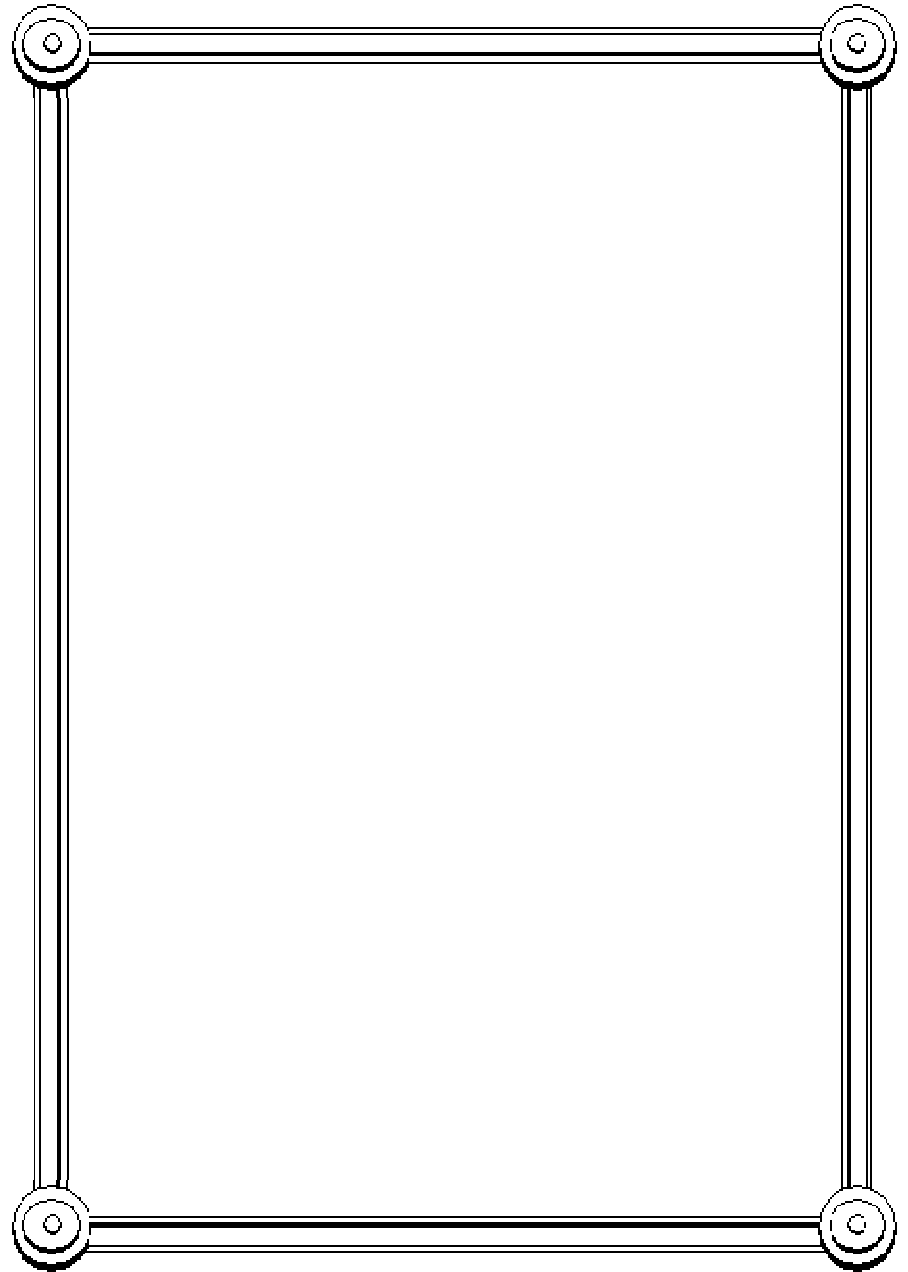
The comments section is for you to talk about something you liked in the story. For example you might comment on something funny, strange, interesting or exciting. You can also colour in the stars to give each book a star rating.

The box at the foot of the page is for you to copy down any words or phrases which you find interesting.

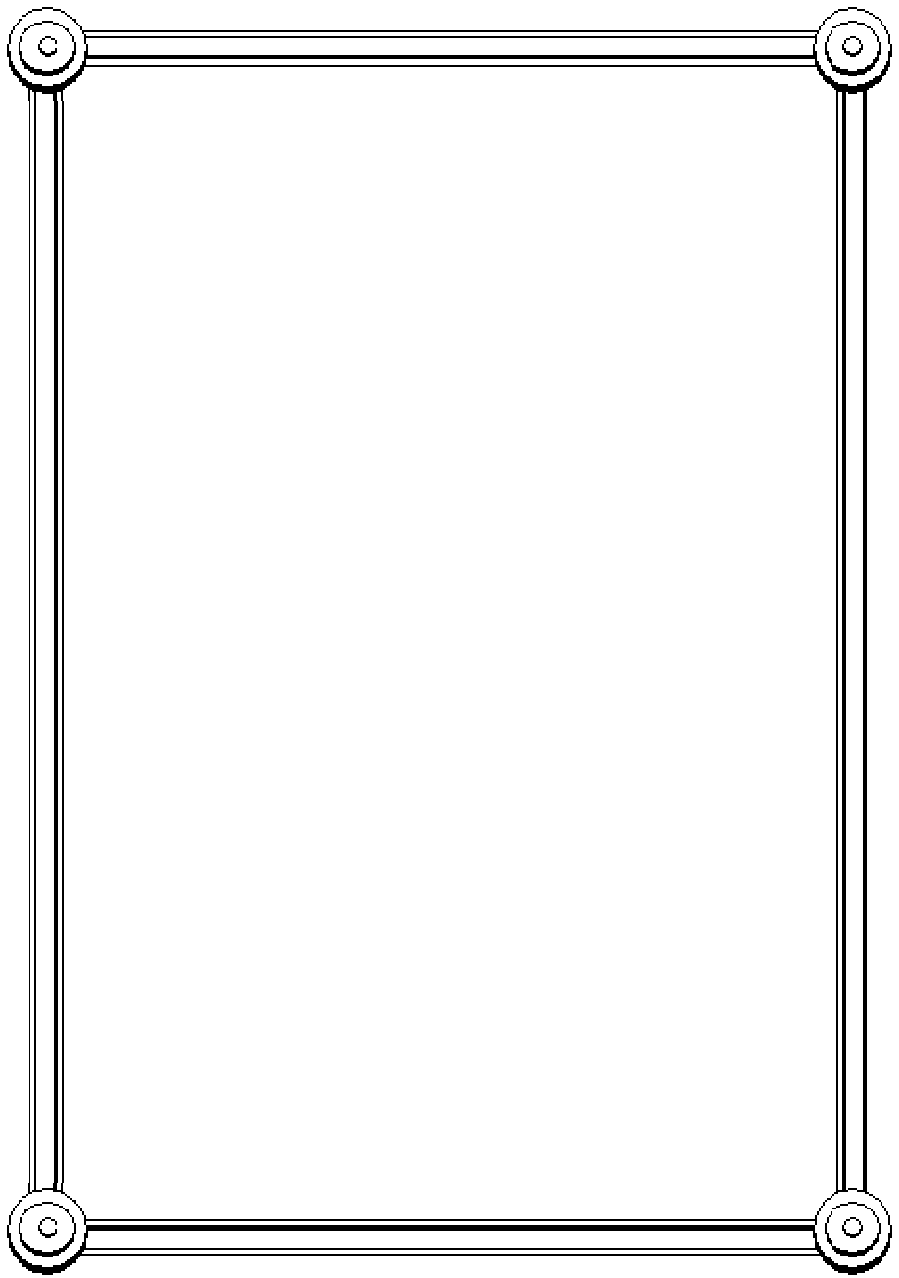
On the blank page you can draw a favourite character or scene from the story.

When you have finished your comments on each book, you can talk with a partner and discuss why you have written and drawn what you have.

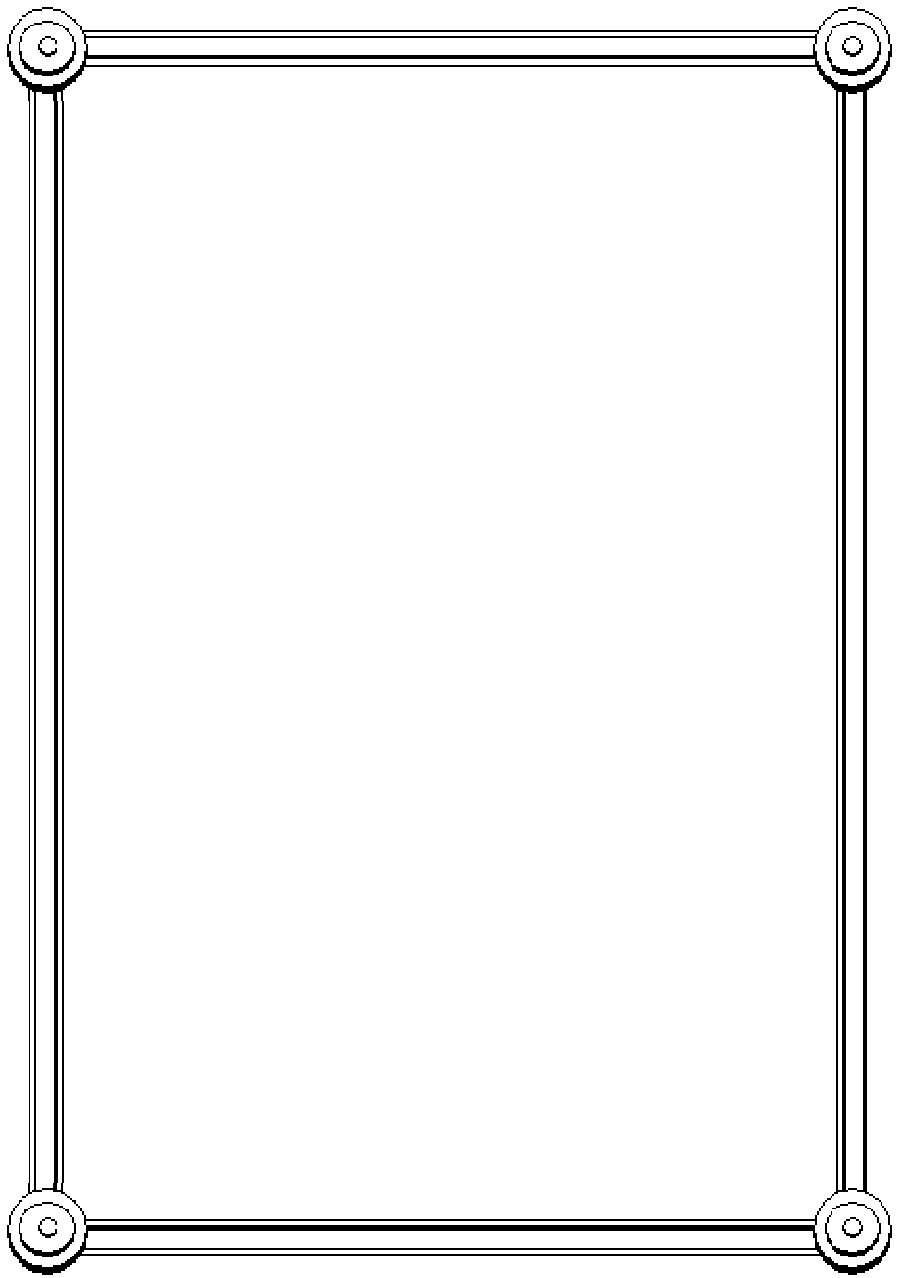
