Word Level Work

KAL

Focus on direct speech

Children notice how direct speech is identified in both French and English.

Text Level Work

Finger rhyme/ action song : *je fais un pas en avant*.

Listen to 2 stories: *Par une sombre nuit de tempête* ; *La tototte*.

Listen to 2 songs by Henri Dès: *Ballon Rond*, *Quand j'étais bébé petit*

Listen to (and sing) 2 traditional songs from the Mon Âne DVD: *Savez-vous planter les choux?*, *Mon Âne*.

Dictionary skills

use real bilingual dictionaries – practise navigating, finding headwords.

Sequencing skills

Days of the week, numbers 0-31.

Cross-curricular Opportunities

Music, Art, PE, literacy, numeracy.

Intercultural Understanding

- Learn a French action song: *Je mets un pas en avant*
- Sing traditional French songs.
- Sing traditional folk songs from the UK.
- Look at some paintings by Monet.

- text cards for numbers 0-20 (words)
